- Length of course: 5-day course, with 40 hours of instruction.
- Course prerequisites:
- At least five (5) years of agriculture safety and health work or professional experience;
- A valid WISHA 10 for Agriculture Workers card
- Applicants are required to submit a complete WISHA 10 ToT application form.
- Course description: Participants integrate instruction on adult learning principles and essential safety and health topics relevant to the agriculture industry. Each participant will facilitate exercises and present WISHA 10 for Agriculture content to demonstrate their skills and abilities as a WISHA 10 Trainer. Training materials will be provided. Participants who successfully complete this course will receive a WISHA 10 for Agriculture Certified Trainer Card, valid for 5 years and will be authorized to conduct WISHA 10 for Agriculture trainings within the agriculture industry.

Successful participants will be able to:

- Effectively instruct on WISHA 10 for Agriculture
- Reference the Safety and Health Standards for Agriculture, Chapter 296-307 WAC.
- Identify the common causes of incidents in hazardous areas of Agriculture.
- Identify principles for eliminating and reducing hazards in Agriculture.
- Influence the Change of the Safety Culture in Agriculture
