The IIMAC, Physical Therapy Association of Washington, and Washington State Podiatric medical Association reviewed and provided input into the document. Several comments were complimentary regarding the extensive work and organizing of evidence in an area that has very few well done systematic reviews to date. Additionally, Public comments were received and the subcommittees proposed responses were presented, with the full committee concurring with the responses.

IICAC's recommendations:

- On page 44, make the diagram labels larger font and darker to increase readability.
- On page 11, in the imaging studies section: Check with the American College of Radiology whether the information is in the public domain.

Vote: The IICAC approved the Foot and Ankle Conditions practice resource for distribution and posting online following the subcommittee addressing the two items above, at their discretion.
