

Catastrophic Care Case Management Project – Update July 2016

- As of July 18, we are tracking 125 catastrophic claims in the Occupational Health Management System (OHMS)
- External Nurse Case Management
 - Qualis contract in place, ready to receive TBI and SCI referrals
 - Paradigm contract is signed
 - Continued assignment of NCMs to claims (5 firms now with signed contracts)
 - 66 / 125 claims with NCM assignment (52.8%)
- Internal Referral Team
 - Interviewing for new catastrophic ONC
 - Position opening for new Medical Program Specialist
- Care Coordination / Discharge Planning
 - Met with Regional ONCs to enhance immediate activities for injured workers
- Centers of Excellence
 - Continuing implementation phase of CoE for amputees with standard referral criteria and process
 - 3 referrals have been sent to CoE for amputees
 - Attended first telemedicine collaborative meeting in Tacoma
 - Continuing discussions with UW regarding CoE for burns
- Evaluation
 - Finalizing study contract with UW
 - Continued discussions with UW research team regarding prospective component and evaluation
 - Institutional Review Board application submitted and in process of being reviewed
