Thank you for submitting a work-related asthma case report to the Safety and Health Assessment and Research for Prevention (SHARP) Program. Cases reported to us are entered into our secure work-related asthma database. The data are regularly analyzed to target resources toward appropriate prevention activities. A number of cases will be chosen each month for further follow-up; therefore, we may contact your patient for a short interview to obtain more information about the workplace factors that contributed to his or her condition.

As a reporting health care provider, we will include your name on our mailing list to receive a semiannual newsletter on work-related asthma. We are also in the process of developing a free CME on work-related asthma and will send this to you once it's complete.
