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f) Work Experience – Direct Entry / Direct Interview

1) Inside Wireman Work Experience – Direct Entry:

i. In lieu of EDUCATION as stated in Section II.A., and TESTING minimum qualifications, individuals who can verify, by providing indisputable documenting evidence, that they have accumulated a minimum of four thousand (4,000) hours specifically in the ELECTRICAL CONSTRUCTION industry trade shall submit a written industry recommendation and they may qualify for direct entry as determined by the JATC if apprenticeship job opportunities are available. If selected, their previous work experience and training shall be evaluated by the JATC using consistent, standard, nondiscriminatory means (see Section IX.E) and thereby awarded advanced standing in the apprenticeship program. For such applicants to be considered:

1. The individual also must provide to the JATC with proper documentation that defines their experience in the electrical construction industry. This documentation must be comprised of official documents from the appropriate state or federal agencies.
2. The JATC will examine all documentation submitted before qualification is acknowledged.
3. An absolute minimum of four thousand (4,000) hours of ELECTRICAL CONSTRUCTION WORK EXPERIENCE must be proven to meet this qualification.

2) Inside Wireman Work Experience – Direct Interview:

i. In lieu of EDUCATION as stated in Section II.A., individuals who can verify, by providing indisputable documenting evidence, that they have worked a minimum of two thousand (2,000) hours specifically in the ELECTRICAL CONSTRUCTION industry trade shall submit a written industry recommendation and may qualify for an oral interview as determined by the JATC if apprenticeship job opportunities are available. The JATC will use standard means of evaluation for the individuals who may qualify for direct interview. Such individuals shall not be required to meet the education requirements under Section II, A.

1. The individual must take the same aptitude test as required of other applicants and receive a passing score of five (5) or higher.
2. The individual also must provide to the JATC proper documentation that defines their work experience in the electrical construction industry. This documentation must be comprised of official documents from the appropriate state or federal agencies.
3. The JATC will exam all documentation submitted before qualification is acknowledged.

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Region 2 Apprenticeship
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4. An absolute minimum of two thousand (2,000) hours of ELECTRICAL CONSTRUCTION WORK EXPERIENCE must be proven to meet this qualification. (Note: meeting this qualification allows the applicant to be interviewed during the normal selection process - this is NOT a form of direct entry.)

3) Residential Wireman and Limited Energy/Sound & Communications Work Experience – Direct Entry:

i. In lieu of EDUCATION as stated in Section II.A., and TESTING minimum qualifications, individuals who can verify, by providing indisputable documenting evidence, that they have accumulated a minimum of twenty-four hundred (2,400) hours of RESIDENTIAL or LIMITED ENERGY/SOUND & COMMUNICATIONS WORK EXPERIENCE, industry trade shall submit a written industry recommendation and they may qualify for direct entry as determined by the JATC if apprenticeship job opportunities are available. If selected, their previous work experience and training shall be evaluated by the JATC or the Subcommittee using consistent, standard, nondiscriminatory means (see Section IX.E) and thereby awarded advanced standing in the apprenticeship program. For such applicants to be considered:

- i. The applicant must provide the JATC with proper documentation that defines their experience in the residential industry (or L.E./S&C). This documentation must be comprised of official documents such as tax/payroll records, notarized letters of experience confirmation and sworn statements.
- ii. The JATC will examine all documentation submitted before qualification is acknowledged.
- iii. An absolute minimum of two thousand four-hundred hours (2,400) of RESIDENTIAL WORK EXPERIENCE (or L.E./S&C) must be proven to meet this qualification.

4) Residential Wireman and Limited Energy/Sound Communication Technician Work Experience – Direct Interview:

a) In lieu of EDUCATION as stated in Section II.A., individuals who can verify with indisputable documenting evidence, that they have worked a minimum of two thousand (2,000) hours specifically in the RESIDENTIAL WORK EXPERIENCE (or L.E./S&C) industry trade shall submit a written industry recommendation and may qualify for an oral interview as determined by the JATC if apprenticeship job opportunities are available. The JATC will use standard means of evaluation for the individuals who may qualify for direct interview. Such individuals shall not be required to meet the education and testing requirements under Section II, Subsection A.

- i. The individual must take the same aptitude test as required of other applicants
 - 1. Residential Wireman applicant test scores will be used for counseling purposes only.
 - 2. Limited Energy/Sound & Communications applicants must obtain a score of four (4) or higher. Applicants failing to obtain a minimum score of four (4) may not retest for a period of six (6) months.
- ii. The individual also must provide to the JATC proper documentation that defines his/her experience in the electrical construction industry. This documentation must be comprised of official documents from the appropriate state or federal agencies.
- iii. The JATC will exam all documentation submitted before qualification is

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acknowledged. An absolute minimum of two thousand (2,000) hours of ELECTRICAL CONSTRUCTION WORK EXPERIENCE must be proven to meet this qualification. (Note: meeting this qualification allows the applicant to be interviewed during the normal selection process - this is NOT a form of direct entry.)

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
