

Elevating Work Platforms

WAC 296-869-100

Scope



This chapter applies to the following types of elevating work platforms:

- Aerial lifts
- Manually propelled elevating work platforms that have a platform that can't be positioned completely beyond the base
- Self-propelled elevating work platforms that have a platform that can't be positioned completely beyond the base
- Boom-supported elevating work platforms that have a boom-supported platform that can be positioned completely beyond the base



Exemption:

- This chapter doesn't apply to elevating work platforms used:
 - By the fire services for fire combat that are covered by Safety Standards for Fire Fighters, Chapter 296-305 WAC**or**
 - For agriculture activities covered by Safety Standards for Agriculture, Chapter 296-307 WAC



Definitions:

Aerial lift: An aerial device mounted on a vehicle such as a truck, trailer, or all-terrain vehicle.

Aerial device: A vehicle-mounted device, telescoping or articulating, or both, which is used to position personnel.

Elevating work platform: A device used to position personnel, along with their necessary tools and materials, at work locations. It includes a platform and an elevating assembly and may be either:

- Vehicle mounted
- or**
- Have an integral chassis providing mobility and a means of support

Platform: The portion of an elevating work platform intended to be occupied by personnel. It may also be called a basket, bucket, stand, or similar term.
