



PREPROPOSAL STATEMENT OF INQUIRY

CR-101 (June 2004)
(Implements RCW 34.05.310)
Do **NOT** use for expedited rule making

Agency: Department of Labor and Industries

Subject of possible rule making: Chapter 296-127 WAC, Prevailing Wage – Scope of Work Descriptions.

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: Chapter 39.12 RCW and RCW 43.22.270

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish:

Prevailing wage rates on public work projects are determined and enforced according to the trade or occupation or "classification" of work actually performed. The purpose of this rulemaking is to write scope of work descriptions for job classifications that have wage rates but no written scope of work description. The department is working with the Prevailing Wage Advisory Committee on the development of scopes. The scope of work descriptions will be filed with the Office of the Code Reviser as they are finalized.
