Purpose: The purpose of this rulemaking is to increase fees 5.53%, which is the Office of Financial Management's maximum allowable fiscal growth rate factor for fiscal year 2008. We evaluated the programs budgets and projected revenue and determined fee increases are necessary to help cover the cost of ongoing services of the Factory Assembled Structures and Plumber Certification programs. The programs received legislative approval for the fee increase.
