Purpose: The purpose of this rulemaking is to make amendments to the reporting requirements in WAC 296-17 and to the classifications in WAC 296-17A. The amendments are being made to correct some grammatical or typographical errors, rearrange information for better readability, and adopt into rule the practice of classifying contractors performing portable snowblowing in classification 0308 landscaping.

Minor housekeeping changes will be made to the following reporting rules in Chapter 296-17 WAC:

296-17-31002 General Definitions. Adding definitions from 35202 to ensure all definitions are in one rule.
296-17-31018 Exception Classifications. Adding two classifications in the list of exception classes which had inadvertently been left out of list of exceptions.

296-17-35202 Definitions. Repealing this rule and placing these definitions into the general definition rule.

296-17-35203(6)(b) Special reporting instructions. Replaced a exclamation mark with a dash.
