Agency: Labor and Industries

Subject of possible rule making:

WAC 296-30-900 What law controls a claim if a statute is amended after the date of the criminal act?

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 7.68.030

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish:

Amending WAC 296-30-900 changes the date of eligibility in accordance with Engrossed Second Substitute Senate Bill (E2SSB) 6504, Chapter 122, Laws of 2010. The amendment will allow for the sunset date of July 1, 2015, to eliminate the need for further rulemaking.
