Purpose of the proposal and its anticipated effects, including any changes in existing rules:

In the 2011 Legislative Session, the Legislature passed Engrossed House Bill (EHB) 2123 addressing the workers' compensation system. This rulemaking addresses the part of EHB 2123 which amended RCW 49.17 to provide permanent funding for the Safety and Health Investment Projects Grants Program. The amendments will be put into Washington Administrative Code (WAC) to make the rules consistent with the legislation and adopt the provisions dictated by statute.

Reasons supporting proposal: The Washington State Legislature mandates that the Division of Occupational Safety and Health enact these rules.

Statutory authority for adoption: RCW 49.17.010, 49.17.040, 49.17.050, 49.17.060
