Purpose of the proposal and its anticipated effects, including any changes in existing rules:
1) Changing the conversion factor used to calculate payment levels for services payable through the Resource Based Relative Value Scale (RBRVS) fee schedule; 2) Changing the conversion factor used to calculate payment for anesthesia services; and 3) Increasing the maximum daily payment for physical and occupational therapy.

WAC 296-20-135(3): Increase the anesthesia conversion factor from \$3.19 to \$3.22.
WAC 296-23-220 and WAC 296-23-230: Increase the maximum daily rate for physical and occupational therapy services from \$118.07 to \$119.01.

Reasons supporting proposal:
This rule will provide medical aid updates regarding rate setting for most professional health care services for injured workers.
