Purpose of the proposal and its anticipated effects, including any changes in existing rules: Labor and Industries was given the authority by Third Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill 5034, which passed the Legislature in 2013, to increase the elevator fees by 13.1%.

Reasons supporting proposal: The elevator program's budget and projected revenue were evaluated and the 13.1% fee increase is necessary to support the program's expenditures which includes the addition of 6 new full time employees (5 inspectors and 1 Technical Specialist) as requested by the department.
