Subject of possible rule making:

WAC 296-30 Rules for the Administration of the Crime Victims Compensation Program, WAC 296-31 Crime Victims Compensation Mental Health Treatment Rules and Fees, WAC 296-33 Attendent Services

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 7.68.030 Duties of the Director – General provisions – Testimony by medical providers.
