Purpose of the proposal and its anticipated effects, including any changes in existing rules:

In order to comport with House Bill 2444 (Chapter 168, Laws of 2016) , DOSH is amending the rules for the Right to Know Fee Assessment Rules under WAC 296-63-005 to remove the reference to the standard industrial code (SIC) system to determine which industries are to be assessed a fee to support the Right-to-Know program. In its place the system used by the Bureau of Labor Statistics will be used.

Reasons supporting proposal: Rule changes are required to implement Chapter 168, Laws of 2016 (HB 2444)

Statutory authority for adoption: Chapter 49.17 RCW and Chapter 49.70 RCW

Statute being implemented: Chapter 168, Laws of 2016 (HB 2444)
