Prior authorization

Prior authorization is required for mental health services. Behavioral Health Services (BHI) doesn't require prior authorization.

For workers covered by L&I (State fund)

- Complete the form *Preauthorization Request for Services for State Fund Workers' Compensation Patients* (F242-397-000). Note: For the initial mental health evaluation, if the diagnosis has not yet been established, you can leave the form's *Diagnosis Description* and *Causal Relationship* fields blank.
- Or, contact the claim manager:
 - By phone: To get the claims manager's phone number, call the Claim Information line at 1-800-831-5227.
 - By secure email: If you are the attending physician, IME, or concurrent care provider, log into the Claim & Account Center (CAC) at Lni.wa.gov/Secure.

For workers employed by self-insured companies
