

WISHA 10 for Agriculture



WISHA 10 for Agriculture is a training designed for workers to help increase their knowledge of safety and health in agriculture jobs.

Learn to avoid the “Top 5” agricultural hazards:

- Struck by machinery or an object
- Falls from heights
- Caught in or between moving objects
- Pesticide exposure
- Improper use or lack of personal protective equipment (PPE)

10 hours of specialized training at no cost:

- Suitable for entry-level workers.
- Available in English and Spanish.
- The training is held over two days, for a total of 10 hours class time (plus breaks and lunch).
- Participants receive a WISHA 10 for Agriculture certification card and certificate of completion.
- Instruction includes presentations, videos, handouts, and interactive exercises.
