Progress Inspection: Each ½ hour		
Progress inspection: (Use progress inspection fees to support the number of inspection trips when other fee items on the permit do not support enough inspection trips.)	\$55.90	

Emergency Inspection Surcharge		
Inspection requested for outside of normal working hours. Surcharge in addition to regular line item permit fees. (Inspection must be prearranged with local office inspection supervisor)	\$141.90	

Other Inspections		
Inspections of a kind not covered by regular inspection fees are charged portal-to-portal per hour:	\$112.60	

Property Owner Requested Inspection of an Existing Installation (Not a permit that allows installation or repair)		
Up to one hour of inspection time	\$112.60	

Notes:

¹ "Inspected with the service" means that a service inspection fee is included on the same electrical work permit.

² "Inspected at the same time" means all wiring is to be ready for inspection during the initial inspection trip

If paying by check, make payable to: Department of Labor & Industries.

Need multiple inspections? Permits where the fee item is less than \$111.80 do not support more than one inspection trip. Add progress inspection fees to support more inspections if your fee does not support inspections needed to complete the inspection process.
