If paying by check, make payable to: Department of Labor & Industries.

Need multiple inspections? Permits where the fee item is less than \$111.80 do not support more than one inspection trip. Add progress inspection fees to support more inspections if your fee does not support inspections needed to complete the inspection process.

¹"Inspected with the service" means that a service inspection fee is included on the same electrical work permit.

² "Inspected at the same time" means all wiring is to be ready for inspection during the initial inspection trip
