## IS IT A MANUFACTURED/MOBILE HOME?

A manufactured/mobile home can be identified by one or more of the following:


1. A certification label on the exterior side of the endwall opposite the hitch from the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) that is red in color and has the following information on it:

AS EVIDENCED BY THIS LABEL NO.

THE MANUFACTURER CERTIFIES TO THE BEST OF THE MANUFACTURER'S KNOWLEDGE AND BELIEF THAT THIS MANUFACTURED HOME HAS BEEN INSPECTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND IS CONSTRUCTED IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE FEDERAL MANUFACTURED HOME CONSTRUCTION AND SAFETY STANDARDS IN EFFECT ON THE DATE OF MANUFACTURE. SEE DATA PLATE.

2. A label on the endwall opposite the hitch or on older units may be next to the front or back door issued by the Department of Labor & Industries that is (or was) red in color and has the following information on it:

- 3. Some or all of the following components:
  - A steel frame that supports the floor.
  - A data plate on the interior if the home that contains the name and address of the manufacturer as well as a statement that, "our manufactured home is designed to comply with..." as well as other information. It is usually located near the main electrical panel box, in the laundry area, inside a closet, on a cabinet door in the bathroom, laundry room, or kitchen.
  - A heat loss certificate that specifies the heating zone for which the home was designed as well as other data pertaining to the home.
  - A serial number will have been stamped on the front metal crossmember.
  - A title that was issued by the Dept. of Licensing.
  - The furnace and water heater have markings on them specifying that they may be used in manufactured/mobile homes.
  - The main electrical panel box has four (4) wires coming into it.
  - The electric range and electric dryer have four (4) connection points.
  - Labels would be applied on the exterior walls near each of the services (i.e. water inlet, electrical inlet, sewer drain).

If your home has any of these items, it is a manufactured/mobile home and requires inspections for all alterations by the Department of Labor and Industries Factory Assembled Structures Section. Please see your local phone book for the nearest L & I office.
