Salary thresholds for overtime exempt workers are a multiplier of state minimum wage for a 40-hour workweek



2022 Salary thresholds

- Small businesses: \$1,014.30/week (\$52,743.60/year)
- Large businesses: \$1,014.30/week (\$52,743.60/year)
