Purpose of the proposal and its anticipated effects, including any changes in existing rules: The purpose of this rulemaking is to propose amendments to the definitions for amusement rides or structures under WAC 296-403A-100. L&I accepted a rulemaking petition to amend the definition of "Amusement structures" to exclude fixed artificial climbing surfaces built for the sport of rock climbing, including equipment used for climber education and safety, when not located on the same

premises as amusement rides. This rulemaking proposes amendments from the petitioner's request. Additional amendments to WAC 296-403A-100 are also being proposed to bring the rule up-to-date.

Proposed amendments:

WAC 296-403A-100, Definitions.

- Clarifies the definition of "amusement structures" to exclude fixed artificial climbing surfaces built for the sport of rock climbing, including equipment used for climber education and safety, when not located on the same premises as amusement rides.
- Amends the definition of "NEC". This includes:
 - Removing the outdated reference to the 2002 edition of the National Electrical Code (NEC) and referencing to the NEC edition adopted in the electrical rules under Chapter 296-46B WAC; and
 - Removing the physical location for obtaining hard copies of the NEC and adds how copies can now be obtained.
- Amends the definitions of "RCW" and "WAC" to clarify that copies of the electrical laws and rules are only available electronically.
- Amends the definition of "amusement rides" to update a reference.
