### **PROCEDURAL:**

- Meeting called to order by Joan Brown at 10:03am
- Approval of Minutes-
  - Approved and seconded the minutes from August 19, 2020 board meeting.

#### **PROGRAM UPDATE:**

- Program update and staffing:
  - Actively recruiting for 2 full time plans examiners.
  - o Working on solutions to secure additional administrative staff.
  - o Backlog:
    - FBS 4 weeks
    - RV 2 weeks
    - MH alterations 2 weeks
    - VEN under 4 weeks
    - RPT under 2 weeks
    - CC no backlog
    - TWH no backlog
    - Tiny House no backlog
  - COVID-19 & Impacts
    - Temporary solutions for out of state inspections
      - Final inspection on site has risks, corrections need to be made.
    - Building code adoption delayed until Feb 1, 2021
    - RV code delayed until July 1, 2021
    - RPT expired in September but can currently apply.
    - Furloughs- seeking exemption
      - Possibility of 1-2 days a month, create a disadvantage to our customers,

creates an underground economy and hazards.

- Planning for the future
  - Electronic plan review MH and VEN have gone to Electronic plan review and we are working with IT to get other products there. RV is next.
  - Online payments and virtual training for Installers.
- Agency legislation for Rulemaking
  - WAC 296-150F
    - CR-101 initiated in July 2019, driven on new legislation in 2019. Changes to building panels, Tiny House and review of all rules for housekeeping. Preliminary draft to board in February.
  - WAC 296-150I &150M
    - Compete review of 150I rules, housekeeping and clarification for both 150I & 150M and to address SEBA audit. Possibly late May early June for public comments.
  - Fee increase of 5.91% for fiscal year 2021 to continue to cover costs. RV product was not included. Increase will go to dedicated 21V fund to go towards FAS needs.
  - Agency is reducing LEG requests. Field Services and Public Safety had two bills removed from the list, adding board members was removed for FAS. Possibly a priority for the 2022 LEG session.
  - Vacant Advisory Board position open for a Professional Engineer.
  - New Business
    - Joan brought up a discussion regarding who can repair a home that has been damaged in transit. Need a clear message to our customers.
    - Mike L. Good chance WSU won't be doing Modular home energy code as of January 2021.
