 - o October 2023 shared first draft at PWAC meeting for review and input by members
 - Written comments were due November 9, 2023
 - Extended to November 30, 2023
 - o February 2024 released the first draft to the public for review and comments
 - o April 12, 2024 virtual feedback session with public
 - Written comments accepted until April 19, 2024
 - o September 9, 2024 second draft released to PWAC
 - September 20, 2024 virtual feedback session with PWAC
 - Second draft released to the public for comments from October 10, 2024 November 8,
 2024
 - o November 27, 2024 shared final version with PWAC

Policy Development Update

Ellen Saline (L&I)

Based on feedback from Stakeholders and considering Program needs we have identified three new policy areas to memorialize guidance. We are in the very early stages development. The draft policies were emailed to PWAC last week. PWAC will have opportunities for comment and input throughout the process.

- Fringe Benefits *Ramon Christensen-Russell (L&I)* Presented policy draft no questions or comments
- Overtime *Reasa Pearson (L&I)*Presented policy draft no questions or comments
- Funding Sources *Ethan Whitener (L&I)*Presented policy draft– no questions or comments

Questions/comments:

- Erin Frasier, WA Building trades
 - o Affordable housing is listed under federal, but this also applies at the state level.
 - o Also, just an FYI but the legislature has allocated funding to L&I to contract with MRSC to commission a study due later this year with further clarification and answers to some of these questions.
- Jerry Vanderwood No question about policy itself...but it is a weedy topic. Is this a policy of all topics? It seems like some of these topics would be an RCW question?
 - Ellen: The intent of policies is not to supersede any RCWs or WACs, but instead to provide a collection of guidance in one place.

SB 2136 Rulemaking

Ethan Whitener (L&I)

- Agency request legislation from AGs office in 2024
- Allows us to extend penalties and sanctions to contractors that are substantially identical to a contractor that violated RCW 39.12.050, RCW 39.12.055. or RCW 39.12.065 or any associated rules
 - o Goes into effect January 1, 2026
- Currently working on expedited rulemaking to add the new statutory language to the WACs
 - o Working to file CR105 on February 18, 2025
 - Any objections to the expedited rulemaking process will need to be received by April 21, 2025
