- C. Tuition
 - 1) All apprentices are responsible for their own tuition and parking fees.
 - (2) Registration for classes will be completed on or prior to the first class in each quarter. Students who do not register quarterly on time. Tuition must be paid within 30 days of when the quarter begins. will not be allowed in class and will be counted as absent until the registration has been completed. Absences If registration or tuition payments have not been completed then they will be handled within the rules stated in Section X, Article B.3, Paragraphs a(1), a(2), and a(3) f(1) f(2) of these standards.

B. Disciplinary Procedures

3. Sponsor Disciplinary Procedures:

(1) All tuition and parking fees are required to be paid within 30 days of the quarter they are owed. If tuition is still due prior to the next scheduled step/percentage increase it will not go into effect until tuition is paid.
