

Spring Yard Safety Tips - Melissa Dunbar

- •Know your equipment Read the owner's manual and all of the safety information. Check with the manufacturer of your tools to make sure there haven't been any safety recalls.
- •**Practice Ladder Safety** Check to make sure your ladder is firmly set on a level surface. Never set ladders on boxes or other objects to make the ladder reach higher areas. Never stand on the top rung or step of a ladder.
- •Watch your children & pets Children and pets can be injured by lawn-care tools. If possible keep them inside while you're mowing or trimming.
- •Check your extension cords Check extension cords for cracks and seal them with electrical tape. Never run extension cords through puddles.
- •Protect your body Wear protective gear; long pants, and non-slip, closed toe shoes. Don't forget your eyes and ears.
- •Know where you're digging Check with your local utility companies before you dig trenches, or holes in your yard to avoid accidentally hitting gas, electrical or sewer lines.


Examiner Exit Survey (6 Responses CY 2024)









CY 2024 IME Complaints Summary







WordBridge Interpretation Services


- All in-person interpreter services and scheduled telephonic and video services via Zoom must be submitted through WordBridge

IME Recording Update



IME Recording Implementation Update

RCW 51.36.070 effective 7/1/23, giving workers the right to record IMEs

 External partners disagree on examiner ability to co-record resulting in delays and/or inability to schedule exams

Department proposed rules to address concerns around co-recording

External feedback did not support moving forward with co-recording rule

Next steps...


- Department is conducting a Third Party Recording Pilot to explore whether offering a secure third party recording service reduces the delays resulting from cancelation and rescheduling of IMEs when a worker chooses to record. Note:
 - Workers may opt to use this service in lieu of using their own device to record
 - Examiners may use service if a worker affirmatively agrees to co-recording
- Pilot will help inform any future rulemaking efforts or changes to IME policies.

IME Third Party Recording Pilot

- L&I has contracted with a vendor to provide a 3rd party recording service (Medical Memory).
- •We will assess if both parties are willing to use a 3rd party recording service.
- •6 months: 3/1/25 through 8/31/25
- Any worker wishing to record can use the service
- Available for co-recording (for those instances when worker still would like to do their own recording)

Desired Outcomes...

- Reduction in the delays resulting from cancellation and rescheduling of IMEs when a worker chooses to record.
- •Less risk and administrative burden associated with maintaining multiple recordings of same exam.
- •Workers may opt to use this service in lieu of using their own device to record and make examiner corecording unnecessary.
- •Mitigates concerns around chain of custody, storage security, and misuse of recordings.
- Inform any future rulemaking efforts or changes to IME policies.





In the Provider dropdown select Washington State IME

Enter Worker First & Last Name, then enter the Claim ID in the Client Number field and tap



Rotate device to landscape. Tap • icon to start recording. Bring the worker into the room and have your appointment as usual.

Pause & resume the video if needed.

Tap Cancel to delete & re-record. Once your patient leaves the room return to the device Save the recording: Tap Gave when done.


Video instantly begins to uploaded.

Measuring Impact

- <u>Utilization</u>: Did access to third party recording improve access to IME providers?
 - Completion rate
 - Referral success rate
- <u>Timeliness</u>:
 - Duration of IME referrals when recording requested





Utilization 1 month in....

- 28 recordings using 3rd party Medical Memory service
- •3 firms currently using (CSP, ExamWorks, MES)
- Authenticated 46 devices
- Onboarding of examiners/firms continues
- •Outreach to broaden awareness of pilot
