Before

- Register life-sustaining & Medical equipment with your utility company
- Service your generator
- Have a disaster preparedness kit
- Have a corded phone & make sure cell phones & back up power supplies are charged
- Have an alternate heat source

During

- Turn off lights & electrical appliances
- Unplug computers & other sensitive equipment
- Leave a lamp on
- Avoid downed power lines
- Keep food safe

After

- Bring electrical appliances & devices back on line gradually & check for damage
- Reset clocks and alarms
- Restock emergency kit
- Run cold water for about 5 minutes to make sure it's clear



Interpreter scheduling issues	6/17/24 Go Live!
Legislative Bill that allowed recording of IMEs	Week of 5/6/24 listening sessions with Business & IME Firms. Held additional listening sessions July and August: Recording Impacts Forensic IMEs 3 rd Party Recording Updated FAQ document online
Fee Schedule Analysis / Clarification	1/12/23: IME Fee schedule was analyzed and updated in 2022. Fee team to re-evaluate the new IME fee policy in 6 months – analyze results of July changes in February Examining reducing administrative burden – firm site visits scheduled 4/3/23: Updates given at May meeting. 9/14/23: Fee increases went into effect 7/1/23. IME Telemed Originating Site Fee presentation and page count analysis presented @ RT. 1/11/24: Troy presented department analysis of IME reimbursement since the fee updates in 2022. The data reviewed shows that around 77% of files are 400 pages or less. The total dollars paid for IMEs continues to increase while the number of exams goes down. The data analysis supports maintaining the current policy of 400 pages or less being bundled into the exam fee. May 2024-Last full analysis that showed 6% increase in 2023; new analysis will be provided at Sept 2024 roundtable on 9/19/24.

2024 IME Complaints YTD














Note: 269 examiners actively associated with SF billed exams (June-August 2024)





IME Recording: Troy Parks

- SHB 1068 effective July 23, 2023, gave workers the right to record independent medical examinations (IMEs).
- Embarking on Phase 2 Department Implementation:
 - Co-Recording Rule
 - 3rd Party Recording Pilot



Rule Writing

- CR101s filed August 21, 2024
 - Co-Recording
 - Third Party Recording Pilot
- Listening sessions to be scheduled in October
 - Draft rules will be provided prior to listening session
- CR 102 anticipated to be filed early December for co-recording WAC



3rd Party Recording Pilot

- Why a pilot? Stakeholder concern with who controls/or owns the recording
 - Offering 3rd party recording option may alleviate concern of recording security
 - Safeguard against manipulation or unauthorized use (chain of custody)
 - Takes the onus of storing recording off of IME firm

What would 6 month pilot entail?



- 3rd party vendor would provide platform for firms to schedule recording (link for examiner to use to start recording)
 - Android/IOS access
 - Laptop, phone, or tablet used to record
- Recording stored by vendor and released gatekeeping by L&I in accordance to draft pilot rules

Pilot-Key Performance Indicators

- Utilization (help inform need for permanent rule)
- Mitigation of scheduling delays
- Inform best practice
 - Camera positioning, etc.

Pilot considerations.....

- Logistics
 - Equipment (firms use their existing equipment)
 - Scheduling procedure
- Need inventory of examiner recording preferences
- Do firms have recording utilization data?
 - Self reporting into scheduling system not fool proof
 - SI utilization

Pilot....what needs to be considered?

- Help inform the pilot-anything we haven't considered?
- Interest in participation?
- Next steps
 - Execute 3rd party recording contract
 - Demo of pilot vendor system





Comparison first 6 months year over year





WordBridge Interpreter Registration (as of 9/13/24)

- Total Language Access Providers (LAPs) in WordBridge: 582
- Total LAPs receiving assignments: 431
- LAPs in the process of completing their registration: 151

WordBridge Provider Registration (as of 9/13/24)

- Total provider accounts in WordBridge: 1,498
- Total provider authorized schedulers: 2,245

Interpreter Services During Implementation of WordBridge

- All in-person interpreter services and scheduled telephonic and video services must be submitted through WordBridge
- □ CTS Language Link on-demand, telephonic interpreter services are available through December 2024.
 - These services may be used as a backup if an in-person interpreter is not secured by SOSi during the transition.
 - Call 877-626-0678 and have the claim ID and other necessary information ready.
 - Providers may continue to access the on-demand telephonic interpreter services through CTS Language Link


