Purpose: The Board of Boiler Rules and Department of Labor & Industries are adopting a fee increase of 5.58 percent to the boiler fees under WAC 296-104-700. This is the Office of Financial Management's maximum allowable fiscal growth factor rate for fiscal year 2023. The current fee levels are not enough to cover current program expenses. A fee increase is needed to ensure the programs' revenues match expenditures; otherwise, service levels may need to be reduced
