Purpose of the proposal and its anticipated effects, including any changes in existing rules: The purpose of this rulemaking is to propose amendments to the Factory Assembled Structures (FAS) rules to increase fees by the fiscal growth factor rate of 6.22 percent. The fee increase is the maximum allowed by the state Office of Financial Management for fiscal year 2024. Reasons supporting proposal: A fee increase is needed to cover increased operating costs and new technology improvements for the FAS Program. The current fee levels are insufficient to cover current Program expenses. The increase will ensure that revenues match expenditures, otherwise service levels may need to be reduced.
