Purpose: This rulemaking adopts amendments to the Factory Assembled Structures (FAS) rules to increase fees by the fiscal growth factor rate of 6.22 percent. The fee increase is the maximum allowed by the state Office of Financial Management for fiscal year 2024. The FAS Program's current fee levels are insufficient to cover current expenses. A fee ncrease is needed to cover the operating expenses of the FAS Program, including funding for new technology to improve service. The increase will ensure that revenues match expenditures.
