Purpose: The purpose of this rulemaking is to adopt amendments to the boiler rules under chapter 296-104 WAC, Board of
Boiler Rules – Substantive. The amendments affect the definitions and fees for boilers and pressure vessels. The adopted
amendments are needed to clarify inspection requirements for pool heaters and increase fees to support the operating
expenses of the Boiler Program.
Adopted amendments to the chapter are as follows:
WAC 296-104-010, Administration—What are the definitions of terms used in this chapter?
