This is the Office of Financial Management's maximum allowable fiscal growth factor rate for scal year 2026. The fee increases are necessary to cover increased operating expenses for the Elevator Program. The current fee levels are insufficient to cover current Program expenses. Additional amendments are also being adopted to
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eorganize the existing fees for permits and inspections into a combined fee schedule.
