Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: This rulemaking is to review prevailing wage rules for housekeeping changes in order to further clarify the language without changing their effect of any rule except where necessary to align with statute or case law. No substantive changes will be considered in this rule.

Possible changes under consideration include:

- Update references to correct current statutes and addresses;
- Change to gender neutral language; and
- Replace archaic terminology.
