**Purpose:** The Prevailing Wage Program reviewed the prevailing wage rules for housekeeping changes in order to further clarify the rules.

Changes include:

- Updated references to correct current statutes and addresses;
- Changes to gender neutral language; and
- Replacement of archaic terminology.

The Prevailing Wage Program notified interested parties by letter of its intention to proceed with a housekeeping rulemaking process and invited them to participate through Prevailing Wage Advisory Committee (PWAC) meetings or their independent communications with L&I. The program worked with the Prevailing Wage Advisory Committee (PWAC), and its representation from business, labor, public agencies, as well as received participation from the public regarding development of the housekeeping rule changes, and consensus was obtained on the proposed changes.
