## Accessibility Review

Guidance and tools to help with ensuring your content meets Accessibility Requirements. Automated testing (i.e. built-in Adobe & Microsoft accessibility checks) can be helpful, but doesn't cover everything. A manual check is required, too!

- [Contrast Checker](#) is a tool that measures the contrast between two colors. Most built-in Accessibility checkers miss this check, so a manual review of color contrast in content needs to be done using this tool.
- [NVDA Screen Reader](#) is a free and widely used screen reader. See also [How to Use NVDA](#) to check Accessibility.
- [Accessibility Insights for Web](#) is the most thorough single tool for assessing WCAG 2.1 AA success criteria. It combines guided manual testing with automated testing.
