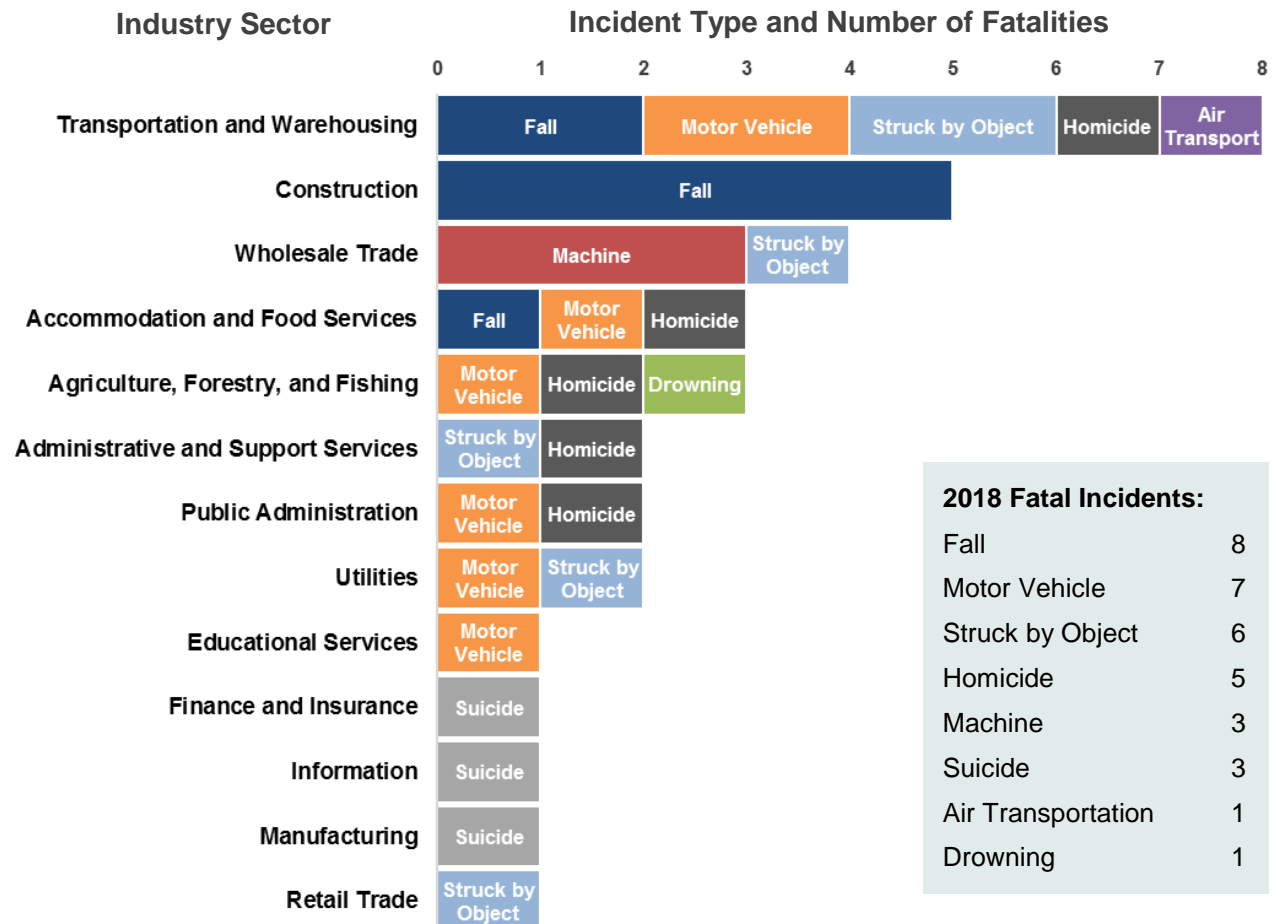


Washington State Work-Related Fatalities: January–June, 2018

Washington Fatality Assessment and Control Evaluation program (WA FACE)¹



- 34 workers died on the job in the first half of 2018.^{2,3}
- The highest number of worker deaths occurred in the transportation and warehousing industry.
- The most frequent incident type was falls.
- All five construction worker deaths were due to falls.
- There were five homicides in the first half of 2018 – equal to the number that occurred in all of 2017.
