
Janitorial Safety Tip Sheet

Unlabeled chemicals can be dangerous!

- The manufacturer's original container with product label is best if it's in good condition (replace any containers that are cracked or missing parts)
 - o Check with the chemical manufacturer for spray bottle requirements
- If you must use another container—avoid ones commonly used for drinking
- Label the new container—use the chemical name and any hazard information from the original packaging
 - Use universal hazard symbols
 - $\circ~$ Adding warning labels in other languages may also be needed
