

Washington State Workplace Homicides, 2019–2024

Recent trends in worker homicide deaths



There were 59 worker homicides between 2019 and 2024, including 44 men and 15 women.¹

• The annual number of worker homicides has increased 41% over the last ten years.

- Almost half (6) of the 13 Transportation worker homicides occurred in 2024.²
- Convenience stores and gas stations accounted for 7 of the 10 Retail industry homicides.
- All seven Public Administration industry homicides were law enforcement officers.
- One-third (12) of Stranger/Criminal intent homicides were attributed to robberies.
- Twenty-two workers were killed while working a shift alone, 3 of whom were in isolated worker positions.³
