Rulemaking steps required by the Administrative Procedures Act, RCW 34.05

- ✓ File a CR-101
 - Filed in April of 2016
- Complete the economic analysis
- File a CR-102 (proposed rule)
- Hold public hearings
- File a CR-103 (formal adoption order)
- Set the effective date

What happens next?

- No decision yet on scheduling a third round of draft reviews
