# Rulemaking steps required by the Administrative Procedures Act, RCW 34.05

- ✓ File a CR-101
  - Filed in April of 2016
- Complete the economic analysis
- ☐ File a CR-102 (proposed rule)
- ☐ Hold public hearings
- ☐ File a CR-103 (formal adoption order)
- ☐ Set the effective date
